Prerequisites: None

Description of Content: A study of the origin and development of the United Methodist Church and its doctrinal standards, with attention to John Wesley's life and thought, subsequent theological transitions, and contemporary guidelines for doctrinal reflection in an ecumenical context. It includes attention to many historic Methodist-related denominations, such as the Evangelical Association, United Brethren, African Methodist Episcopal Church, African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church, and Christian Methodist Episcopal Church. Students will demonstrate an understanding of UM history and an ability to apply UM doctrine to real ministry throughout both the ordination process and their life in ministry. This course is required of United Methodist students for ordination.

Class Procedures:

Lectures, individual seminar paper presentations and discussions, group work

Requirements:

1. Attendance and informed participation in the class sessions
2. Journal comprised of a) weekly responses to prompts, reflecting thoughtful, complete engagement with the readings (1 page maximum each) and b) a terminology sheet
3. In-class presentation of a seminar paper (5-7 pages)
4. Final Take-home Exam (12-15 pages total)
