

**One Page Updated COVID-19 Guidance**  
**(Informed by CDC Regulations)**

- CDC recommends universal indoor masking for all teachers/professors, staff, students, and visitors to schools, regardless of vaccination status.
- Faculty, staff and students should perform daily self-monitoring for potential COVID-19 symptoms.
  - If you are **staff** and experience new or increasingly severe symptoms, self-isolate and communicate with the person to whom your report directly at Brite.
  - If you are **faculty**, self-isolate and communicate with Dean Michael Miller.
  - If you are a **student**, self-isolate and communicate with your instructor and Dean Michael Miller.
- ⇒ **This is to be done regardless of vaccination status.**
- Close contacts of those who have tested positive should be tested for COVID-19 **within three to five days** of known exposure or notification of exposure. If unvaccinated, you should immediately start a **10-day quarantine**. If vaccinated, you need not quarantine but should wear a mask indoors **everywhere for 14 days** or until you've received a negative test result.
- If you are a student, **contact your professor(s) to discuss ways to stay engaged with class material** while awaiting test results.
- Staff should work-out with their supervisors how they will complete their duties while quarantined.
- Supervisors associated with the Dean' office should work-out these details with the Dean; others should do so with the President.
- If you test negative for COVID-19 (vaccinated or unvaccinated) you should wear a mask indoors **everywhere for 14 days** and be prepared to show evidence of your negative result before returning to in-person engagement.
- If you test positive for COVID-19, and are vaccinated, you should inform the TCU Health Center (<https://www.tcu.edu/protect-the-purple/what-to-do.php>) and those listed under the first bullet point, remain isolated **for 10 days** from the onset of symptoms, and **after 24 hours** with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and evidence that other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving. You should wear a mask indoors **everywhere for 14 days**, and prepare to provide proof of a negative test result to your supervisor (staff) or to Dean Miller (students and faculty) before returning to in-person interaction.
- If you test positive for COVID-19, and are unvaccinated, you should inform the TCU Health Center (<https://www.tcu.edu/protect-the-purple/what-to-do.php>) and those listed under the first bullet point, remain isolated **for 10 days** from the onset of symptoms, **after 24 hours** with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and evidence that other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving. - If you test positive for COVID-19 but have no symptoms, you should follow the regulations that apply to those with symptoms.
