

NETE 75013—Basics of Biblical Greek II
(3 semester hours)

Prerequisites: NETE 70013 or equivalent experience

Description of Content:

This course will continue the work of NETE 70013 and help you build a firm foundation in biblical Greek by emphasizing the basics of Koine Greek morphology (the way words are put together), syntax (the way phrases are put together), and vocabulary, strengthened by continual review through memorization, exercises, and translation. This course is the second in a two-semester sequence.

Class Procedures:

Review and discussion of assigned exercises and translations; instructor presentations with engaged student participation.

2. Preparation for class, including completion of homework and translation projects
3. Regular quizzes and exams
