### PRTH 70970 – Episcopal Church Liturgy and the Book of Common Prayer – Intensive 3 Semester Hours

Instructor: The Rev. Canon Andrew R. Wright, Th.D.

Prerequisites: None

Description of Content: Examination and application of liturgical principles and planning for Episcopal Church worship, with a specific emphasis on the history, theology, and use of the Book of Common Prayer. This class is taught in an intensive form, meeting in session for one class week. There are assignments prior to and after the week of class sessions.

Class Procedures:

This class will consist of lectures, class discussions, and practical presentations.

Requirements:

1. Readings assigned prior to the week of class sessions.
2. Attendance and informed participation in the class sessions
3. Short assignments and/or practical presentations during the week of class, including in-class quizzes/exams
4. 2 Course papers (10-12 pages each), due after class sessions have concluded
